



Open the **Google Play™** store app. Search for **Atrium on the Go**, and then tap the app from the results to view a page with images from the app, install options, overview information, requirements, etc. Tap **INSTALL**. You may be prompted to give the app permission to access certain areas of your device; tap **ACCEPT**. You will see a **Downloading...** and **Installing...** message; when the process is finished, tap **OPEN**.

Settings
